I had to scrutinize every monument and stone in the city, just as I had to architecturally photograph and draw as much as I could until I was able to develop books that would match and reflect the value of Al-Quds and Islam based on thousands of sources and tens of thousands of documents, drawings, inscriptions, and historical maps which consumed me throughout every moment of field research or while in libraries.
